CALIFORNIA BENEDICT – 16

Tomato, sliced avocado, and red onion with two poached eggs and hollandaise sauce over a split English muffin. Served with a side of home fries.

BOW STREET BENEDICT – 16

Applewood smoked bacon, poached eggs, and hollandaise sauce over a split English muffin. Served with a side of home fries.

WHARF PAIN PURDUE – 12

Three slices of brioche French toast with fresh Maine blueberries, whipped cream, and warm maple syrup. Served with a side of home fries.

VEGGIE FRITTATA – 16

Tomatoes, bell peppers, red onion, asparagus, mushrooms, and smoked cheddar cheese. Served with a side of home fries.

BACON FRITTATA – 16

Applewood smoked bacon and smoked cheddar cheese. Served with a side of home fries.

YOGURT BOWL – 15

Sliced avocado, fresh blueberries, lime zest, toasted pistachios, and raspberry coulis over yogurt.

AVOCADO TOAST – 9

Fresh avocado spread across toasted sour dough, topped with everything bagel seasoning and pickled onions. Served with a side of home fries.

WHAT'S ON THE MENU?

Benedict / A common American breakfast dish classically consisting of English muffins, poached eggs, Canadian bacon, and hollandaise sauce.

Hollandaise Sauce / One of the classic French "mother" sauces, hollandaise sauce is an emulsion of egg yolk, clarified butter, lemon juice, and white wine. It is often seasoned with hot sauce, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper.

Pain Purdue / Fancy name for French toast. Translated as "lost bread"

Frittata / Frittata is an egg-based Italian dish similar to an omelet or crustless quiche or scrambled eggs, enriched with additional ingredients such as meats, cheeses, or vegetables. The word frittata is Italian and roughly translates to "fried".
